

Outback Explorer Safari

Departs: 11.30am daily from the Lodge Interpretive Centre

Returns: 1.30pm

Includes: Picnic lunch, optional dip in Douglas Creek.

Duration: 2 Hours

What to bring: Sunhat, sunscreen, insect repellent, camera, water bottle (optional binoculars, swimmers and towel)



Tour Description

At 11.30 we take to the 4wd tracks of the 2000 hectare Mareeba Tropical Savanna and Wetland Reserve with your safari guide in our custom built, open-sided safari vehicle. We continue to the Northern section of the Reserve to enjoy a picnic lunch and opportunity to relax in the waters of the picturesque Douglas Cascades.

After lunch, we travel the Douglas Track, looking for the Reserve wildlife, making our way to the western side of the Reserve to Balancing Lagoon. Travelling past delightful Lily Lagoon and through Pandanus Flat, we return to the Interpretive Centre and finish at 1.30 after a bush picnic lunch in the Australian Outback.
